Mission Statement

The Quinte Regional Science and Technology Fair aims to inspire local youth to develop enthusiasm, confidence, and lifelong interest in science, technology, and engineering, while equipping them with valuable skills and opportunities.

Why Science Fairs?

Science Fairs offer students in grades 4 to 12 the opportunity to perform original scientific research or create innovative projects which are then constructively and rigorously reviewed. Science Fairs are offered at school, district, regional, national and international levels. The top regional science fair projects are entered into the national fair where young people share a week of competition, socializing, cultural activities, scientific tours and workshops. Some students also go on to attend international Science Fairs.

Science Fairs encourage students to meet and learn with experienced scientists and technologists, to discover where new career opportunities exist and to make industry contacts which could lead to a career. Students who develop Science Fair projects always agree that they have fun doing the work while learning something new about the world around them. Their Science Fair project work provides an opportunity to extend science beyond the classroom and to take an in-depth look at a topic that is of interest to them personally.

Canada Wide Science Fair

The Youth Science Canada showcase event, the Canada-Wide Science Fair (CWSF) is the largest extracurricular youth activity related to science and technology in Canada. Each year some 450 young scientists are chosen to compete from the top ranks of approximately 25,000 competitors at over 100 regional science and technology fairs staged across the country.

QRSTF History

Over the last 65 years we have been located in the Armories, schools, the Quinte Mall, Loyalist College and in 2026 at St. Theresa Catholic Secondary School. We have provided a venue for thousands of students to showcase their science knowledge. Many of our winners from the Quinte region have won national recognition. Last year we successfully held our Fair at St. Theresa Catholic Secondary School. The script of our 2026 Awards Ceremony can be accessed at qrstf.ca. Additionally, these contributions help send students and delegates from Hastings-Prince Edward Counties to the Canada Wide Science Fair, to be held in Hamilton in May of 2027. The QRSTF committee operates as a volunteer-driven, non-profit corporation and is a registered charity. No sponsorship funds are used for salaries.
